A 55-year-old man is referred to your office because of 2 months of constipation, feeling a lump in the anal canal with bowel movements, and frequent bright red blood with bowel movements. He denies rectal pain on defecation or a change in his appetite or weight. He has no other significant medical or family history. The patient has already tried medical therapy with fiber supplements, stool softener, and avoidance of straining. He still has rectal bleeding. On digital examination he denies a significant amount of pain, and his sphincter tone is normal. During a subsequent rectosigmoidoscopy, you see these findings on retroflexed view within the rectum (Fig. 1) and during careful withdrawal through the anal canal (Fig. 2 and Video 1).
