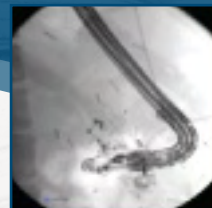

# Therapeutic EUS for Advanced Practicing Endosonographers

## ► WHY YOU SHOULD PARTICIPATE

This two-day course has been developed to provide a comprehensive overview of therapeutic endoscopic ultrasound (EUS) that will take the practicing endosonographers from theory to the hands-on practice of EUS, while discussing and demonstrating the fine points of the procedure. Attendees will be exposed to everything regarding equipment, technical aspects, diagnostic utility, therapeutic uses, and general role of EUS in the care of patients with gastrointestinal and non-gastrointestinal disorders.

During the didactic portion of the course, renowned faculty will provide concise reviews and pertinent information regarding EUS, which will be supported by case discussions and debates. While in the bio-skills lab, attendees will be guided through an intensive hands-on experience, which will include fluoroscopy and animate models at various stations, allowing attendees to perform many of the procedures encountered in everyday practice, while focusing on new and evolving advanced therapeutic applications of EUS.

## ► WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Practicing gastrointestinal endoscopists who have experience with diagnostic EUS and are interested in developing and refining their therapeutic EUS skills.

## ► WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Upon completion of this educational activity, participants will be able to:

- Identify the adverse events and management strategies associated with therapeutic EUS
- Identify the utility and role of EUS for accessing and draining the bile and pancreatic ducts
- Identify the utility and role of EUS-guided celiac plexus block and celiac plexus neurolysis
- Recognize the technical aspects and role of therapeutic EUS procedures
- Differentiate the various types of EUS-guided therapies for cyst and tumor ablation
- Apply techniques of EUS guided treatment of pancreatic pseudocysts and walled off necrosis
- Discuss the different techniques for EUS-guided tissue acquisition
- Discuss the current management options for pancreatic cysts
