

ASGE Advanced Endoscopy Training Program Directors

OVERVIEW: Training programs who participate in ASGE's 4th year Advanced Endoscopy Match, commonly offer a one-year program devoted to clinical and research training in endoscopic retrograde cholangioscopy (ERCP), endoscopic ultrasound (EUS), advanced polypectomy techniques (including endoscopic mucosal resection and endoscopic submucosal dissection), and endoluminal stenting. Some programs will offer additional experiences and involvement in POEM procedures, device assisted enteroscopy, and endoscopic suturing cases.

These programs provide fellows with the skills required for successful pursuit of a career as a therapeutic endoscopist in either an academic or private practice setting.

ASGE AEF MATCH: ASGE offers a formal match program in conjunction with participating advanced endoscopy training programs to make the process of application and interviewing fair and efficient for both the programs and fellows. The training year typically begins in July and is available to those who have completed a standard three-year gastroenterology fellowship and are American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM) GI eligible. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Advanced Endoscopy Training Programs are commonly a one-year in duration. The training year typically begins in July and is available to those who have completed a standard three-year ACGME accredited gastroenterology fellowship. Those from a non-ACGME accredited program must have at least three years of GI education prior to submitting an application. An application packet in the ASGE match process consists of:

1. ASGE Application
2. Post-Undergraduate Education
3. USMLE Scores (if necessary)
4. Certification of Completion of Residency
5. Prior to appointment in the advanced endoscopy fellowship, fellows should have completed a three-year ACGME-accredited gastroenterology fellowship
6. Fellows from non-ACGME-accredited programs must have completed at least three years of gastroenterology education prior to starting the fellowship
7. Personal Statement
8. Curriculum Vitae
9. 3 Letters of Reference
